Would you like to make the most of your Mimeo Board? Are you only using it as a projection screen? "Gimme GimKit! That's what the students say!" - GimKit is a live quiz learning game students beg to play using technology. It's perfect for remote learning or in a classroom setting. If you are struggling with student engagement or are seeking a new way to ensure mastery, this will fire up your class! Students make "money" to purchase power ups, which entices them to compete (and learn!). Teachers can customize these games or search the database for ones to utilize.

"Rigor through Rap using Flocabulary" - This review provides the basics on how to utilize all that this program offers. With standards-based songs and videos for auditory and visual learning, students on all levels can reap big learning benefits. Teachers have access to assessments and assignments that can be printed or completed digitally, with the data readily accessible for re-teaching or review.

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Plickers & Polls – Taught by Daniel Szokoly

Plickers is a cool (non-contact) formative assessment tool for use in classrooms. Students use a QR barcode that they put on their folder for the class. This allows them folder with their answer choice on top and I can scan them all with one swipe of my phone. The data is stored and organized for teacher use. Great for Pirate **Poll Everywhere** uses similar software to Remind and is a great formative assessment during and at the end of class. Students will use their devices to text their responses to the class number and it will appear as a stream of consciousness on the board. This is great for open-ended response questions with the intention
